

Bodmin Town Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2001

Notice is hereby given that Bodmin Town Council proposes to make amendments to the Bodmin Town Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2001, as detailed below:

- 1) Amendment to area covered by the Order to include St Petroc's Close, a private road owned by Bodmin Town Council and used as an emergency access/exit from Priory Car Park.
- 2) Amendment of the Schedule to increase tariff, last changed in 2001, as detailed below:
- 3) Amendment to the times of operation, last changed in 1991, increasing the hours of charging until 8.00 p.m. in the evenings and Sundays (excluding area of car boot sale).

- 4) Amendment of Excess Charge to £60 with provision for a discount to £10 for prompt payment where settlement is received within 72 hours of the date of issue.

The Council's reasons for requiring the Amendments are:

- 1) To enable the road to continue to be used as an effective emergency access/exit from Priory Car Park; and
- 2) To bring the tariff into line with other local authority operated Shoppers' Car Parks, providing uniformity throughout the Town. To increase the parking charges to offset the cost of inflation, maintenance and running expenses including surface repairs to the car park. Note that the tariff has not been increased since 2001.
